## **Why a Preventative Maintenance Program**

Like any other piece of equipment within your work place, waste and recycling equipment needs preventative maintenance to sustain uninterrupted and reliable service. Unexpected down time is one of the most costly and resource depleting problems we see in business today. BDN sees compactors and balers broken down on a daily basis. Many of these circumstances could be avoided if there had been regular maintenance and some of the warning signs of failure had not gone unnoticed.

BDN is capable of handling sales, service and maintenance on a national level. Wherever your locations may be, one call is all you need to have your equipment needs handled in a quick and professional manner.

## **What is Done and When it's Done**

On a quarterly basis, a BDN technician will inspect each piece of equipment and perform all items on our Preventative Maintenance Program (PM). Key items inspected include:

**Operation:** Warning lights, pressure gauge, key switches and emergency stop. Also inspect and adjust all safety and limit switches.

**The hydraulic system:** Condition of hydraulic hoses, signs of wear or leaks, oil level, and check the cylinder(s).

**Structure:** Physical appearance, wear points, ground anchors, wiper blade and follower plate.

**Movable Parts:** Inspect and lubricate door hinges, door handles, paddle latches, turnbuckles, access gates, motor, motor coupling, ram track and guides.

Before leaving every PM location a BDN technician shall have an authorized employee of the client sign the inspection sheet to ensure critical information is relayed to the client immediately. If any further service is required, BDN shall only perform work that is authorized with a Purchase Order from the client.



## **PM Pricing and Billing**

BDN's typical PM programs are based on annual agreements and are billed on a quarterly basis. This means that our Technician shall be on site 4 times per year, greatly minimizing any potential equipment stoppage. With BDN being able to handle sales, service, and maintenance clear across Canada, we can become your 'one stop shop' for all your waste and recycling equipment needs – BDN will simply grow and go wherever the client dictates.

The following details pricing for BDN's PM Program based on quarterly visits and billing:

### **British Columbia locations:**

Quarterly maintenance of each compactor = \$300.00 per location

Baler maintenance at same location = \$25.00 per location

Additional compactor at same location = \$125.00 per location

Double Stacking compactor locations = \$388.00 per location

### **All other Canadian locations:**

Quarterly maintenance of each compactor = \$375.00 per location

Baler maintenance at same location = \$38.00 per location

Additional compactor at same location = \$135.00 per location

Double Stacking compactor locations = \$488.00 per location
